

## Short CV – Michael Musalek, 20.3.1955

Michael Musalek was born in Vienna, Austria on March 26, 1955. He studied medicine and obtained his MD (1979) at the University of Vienna, Medical School, Austria. In 1986, he qualified as Specialist for Psychiatry and Neurology; in 1993, qualification as Psychotherapist. From 1989 to 2001 he worked as Head-Psychiatrist at the Department of Psychiatry, University of Vienna; 1989 – 2003 he was Head of the Liaison Clinic for Psychodermatology at the Department of Dermatology, University of Vienna. In 1990, he qualified as Senior University Lecturer for Psychiatry (“venia docendi”); in 1997 he was appointed as Professor of Psychiatry at the University of Vienna, Medical School, Austria; since 2001 he is Medical Director of a Department for Alcoholism and Drug Addiction at the Anton Proksch Institute Vienna and since April 2004 General Medical Director of the Anton Proksch Institute, Vienna (one of the biggest Addiction Clinic in Europe – more than 200 co-workers, 300 beds, 7 out-patient clinics, at about 12.000 treated patients/year, ca. 2000 in-patients and 10.000 out-patients), since 2007 Vice Chairman of the Research Division for Mental Health (Health and Life Science University, Hall/Austria); Visiting Professor of the Sigmund Freud University Vienna and Visiting Professor of the University Belgrade – Clinic for Psychiatry CCS & School of Medicine. Since 2015 he is Head of the Institute for Social Aesthetics and Mental Health of the Sigmund Freud Private University Vienna.

Prof. Musalek is Secretary for Sections of the European Psychiatric Association (EPA - since 2005); Member of the EPA Board (since 1994); was member of the Executive Committee of the EPA (2005 - 2012); EPA Delegate in the Section Psychiatry and the Board of Psychiatry of the Union Européenne des Médecins Spécialistes (UEMS – 1999 – 2007), Delegate of Austrian Society for Psychiatry, Psychotherapy and Psychosomatics of the Section Psychiatry since 2018. He is Founding Member and Chairman of the EPA Section Psychopathology; Founding Member and Board Member of the EPA Section for Alcoholism and Drug Addiction; Founding Member of the EPA Section for Philosophy and Psychiatry; for three years he was the Chairman of the EPA Board for Education, and later the Chairman of the EPA Task Force Committee for Education and Member of the CME Accreditation Committee of the EPA, from 2004-2005 Chairman of the CME/CPD Evaluation Committee and Member of the Recommended Guidance Steering Group (EPA); since 2013 he is Committee Member of the EPA Committee of Education; furthermore he is Committee Member of the Standing Committee on Education of the World Psychiatric Association (WPA), Chairman of the WPA Section Clinical Psychopathology; Founding Member of the WPA Section Philosophy and Humanities, Honorary Member of the World Psychiatric Association (WPA); Past President of the Austrian Society of Psychiatry and Psychotherapy (ÖGPP; President from 2007-2011). Member of the World Federation of Societies of Biological Psychiatry Guideline Task Force on Addiction Disorders; Member of the World Federation of Societies of Biological Psychiatry Task Force on Nosology and Psychopathology; Past President of the European Society for Dermatology and Psychiatry; and Honorary Member of the Società Italiana di Psicopatologia. Member of the European Forum for Responsible Drinking (EFRD), President of the European Society of Aesthetics and Medicine (ESAM); Member of the International Network for Philosophy and Psychiatry (INPP), Member of the Section Philosophische Grundlagen der Psychiatrie und Psychotherapie of the Deutsche Gesellschaft für Psychiatrie und Psychotherapie, Psychosomatik und Nervenheilkunde (DGPPN); Member of the Jury of the DGPPN-Philosophy-price. He is since 2009 President of the Erwin Ringel Institute (Erwin Ringel Stiftungsfond); and since 2010 President der Österreichischen Gesellschaft für Arbeitsqualität und Burn-out (Burn-AUT)

Furthermore he is Member of the Scientific Board of the scientific journal "Die Psychiatrie", member of the Editorial Board "Psychopraxis" and of the "Arzneimittelpfprofil"; and a Member of the Scientific Advisory Board of the journal "Clinicum Neuropsy".

He has published more than 300 scientific publications, most of these are concerned with his main interests in psychiatry research: social aesthetics and mental health, clinical psychopathology, nosology and classification, alcoholism and drug addiction, liaison-psychiatry, psychodermatology, social psychiatry, treatment research, psychotherapy and philosophy and psychotherapy.
